



K-LINE SPEEDTILLER

The K-Line Speedtiller is manufactured at Cowra, NSW.

Available in working widths of 1.75m to 9m, the Speedtiller has been manufactured specifically for stubble incorporation.

Two rows of scalloped edged, 560mm diameter discs are the basis of the design. The disc rows are followed by a roller.

Standard fitment is a crumble roller and there are options of pipe rollers and coil packer rollers.

In ideal conditions the Speedtiller can cultivate to a depth of 100mm, which means it can be used as a primary tillage tool in some cases.

Ground speed can be as high as 18km/h, but 15km/h is more typical.

Linkage units up to 3.5m are available, while hydraulic fold models up to 9m are also available.

Each disc tine is mounted to the frame via four pieces of rubber to provide shock absorption and aid penetration of the disc by creating vibrations.



The frame is made from 10mm RHS steel and disc bearings are sealed.

K-Line also manufactures the Trashcutter, which is suitable for cutting and knocking down stubble.

The Trashcutter first lays the stubble down on the ground, which is then cut by a series of in-line, self-sharpening coulters spaced 130mm apart.

The disc angle as well as the down force can be adjusted.

OWNER COMMENT

We bought the first Speedtiller K-Line made. It's a 5m trailing unit and it does a great job of lightly cultivating the soil and helping to break up the stubble.

It leaves the paddocks in an ideal condition where we can run a levelling board over them and sow lucerne.

We mulch the stubble first, with a 6m slasher before we run the Speedtiller over it with a 120kW tractor at a groundspeed of about 10km/h.

I can't really suggest any improvements as we've had no dramas with it.
